2019/20 PUBLIC SECTOR INVESTMENT PROGRAMME (PSIP) CIRCULAR No. 1

I write to inform you that the Ministry of Finance, Economic Planning and Development (MoFE PD), through the Department of Economic Planning and Development (EPD), has commenced the formulation of the 2019/20-23/24 PSIP. In this regard, Government Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) are requested to prepare and submit all new and on-going project proposal templates by 31st August, 2018. The submissions should include projects being supported by development partners.

The Government continues to use the Malawi Growth and Development Strategy (MGDS III) as the medium term overarching strategy. In this regard, the appraisal and approval of projects will only be done on projects that are in line with the MGDS III and those that demonstrate value for money.

As a way of optimising use of resources while at the same time ensuring maximum impact of interventions, please note that Government will continue to prioritize Flagship Projects as outlined in the MGDS III and completion of on-going projects while limiting inclusion of new projects to only those deemed critical. MoFE PD is also encouraging MDAs to submit only those project proposals that are capital and infrastructural in nature, and are in line with the MGDS III priorities

Attached to this Circular 1 are the PSIP Guidelines to assist you in preparing the FY2019/20 PSIP submissions.

MDAs are advised to contact their respective PSIP desk officers as outlined in the guidelines or access them through: <http://psip.malawi.gov.mw> via GWAN or any other internet.
